

MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION
(Registration Under Societies Act, XXI of 1860)
of
Association of Assam Vets in Poultry Industry

1. The name of the Society will be called "Association of Assam Vets in Poultry Industry" (AAVPI).
2. The registered office of the Society is situated in the state of Assam. The complete address of the office of the Society is - HouseNo-115, JIRONI, Saneki Path, Baghorbori, P.O- Panjabari, Dist- Kamrup (M), Guwahati, Assam, Pin-781037 and the operation shall apply to the whole of India.
3. The Objects of the Society shall be all or any combinations of the followings:
 - I. To establish a communication channel to connect with all the veterinarians from Assam who are engaged in Poultry industry all over the country or abroad.
 - II. To provide facilities for exchange of information and opinion of interest to Poultry farming both Broilers & Layers, Poultry medicines & vaccines manufacturers, Feed mills, Hatcheries and Poultry Breeder Farms and allied sectors.
 - III. To establish communication network with young budding Vets to be a part of Poultry Industry with a purpose of strengthen future competent resources in the sector by conducting online & offline seminars & workshops in the Veterinary colleges and other public and Private Institutions.
 - IV. Knowledge sharing sessions about entrepreneurship development in Poultry sector , Leadership development program for its members, expert talks on development of poultry industry, farm management, bio-security and disease diagnosis for poultry farmers & students.
 - V. To represent poultry farming needs to the Union Government, State Government and all bodies that impact the poultry farming activity in Assam and in other states of India.
 - VI. To collect and maintain information of poultry farming activity in the


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State. Sharing the same with its members, Government bodies and policymakers of the State.

- VII. To liaise between poultry farming community, educational institutions and research institutions.
- VIII. Co-operate with industrial, business, educational and research institutions and other organizations in the collection and exchange of information pertaining to Poultry Farming, Poultry medicines & vaccines manufacturers, Feed mills, Hatcheries and Poultry Breeder Farm etc.
- IX. To promote entrepreneurship in the field of Poultry farming, breeding, feed milling and hatcheries or any other ventures related to poultry Industry.
- X. To undertake professional, technical and management consultation services.
- XI. To undertake studies, survey and research project. To organize common service facilities for its members.
- XII. To conduct, undertake and participate in National and International Exhibition;
- XIII. To attain those advantages by united action, which each member-unit may not be able to accomplish in its separate capacity.
- XIV. To construct or alter or keep in repair any buildings required or used by or for the Association and to pulldown or demolish any buildings not to required.
- XV. To establish and support or aid in the establishment and support of associations, institutions, funds, trusts and convenience, calculated, to benefit employees of the Association for the dependents or connection of such persons and grant pension and allowances and make payments towards insurance and to subscribe or guarantee moneys for charitable or benevolent objects or for any exhibition for any public, general, useful object.
- XVI. To enter in to any arrangement with any Government or authority supreme, municipal local or otherwise that may seem conducive to the Association's objects or any such persons of them and to obtain from any such Government or authority all rights, concessions and privileges, which the Association may think it describe to obtain and to carry out, exercise and comply with any such arrangement.
- XVII. To undertake and execute any trust the undertaking of which may seem to the

Association desirable either gratuitously or otherwise.

- XVIII. To bring out and publish for sale or private circulation or free distribution, books, newspapers, periodicals, pamphlets or any other publications.
- XIX. To establish and operate poultry product display centers, sub-contracting exchanges and other institutions for the benefit of Poultry Farming, Hatcheries and Feed mills.
- XX. To organize exhibitions, trade fairs, marketing activities & to undertake generic activities that creates awareness about health benefits of Poultry meat and eggs. Also to help increase poultry & poultry product consumption, achieving aims & objects of the association but not to carry any commercial activities resulting in profits".
- XXI. To purchase or acquire technical know-how for development of Poultry Industry.
- XXII. To establish test centers, laboratories, common facility centers and undertakes any type of research and development activity, etc. for the Poultry farming and allied sector.
- XXIII. To work & cooperate with other bodies (industrial, business, educational research, Skill development & training institutions) for conducting joint/ sponsorship skill development programme, that would help in providing skilled manpower to Poultry Industry.
- XXIV. To generally do all other things incidental to the attainment of the objects.

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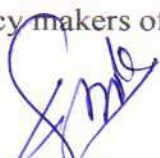

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RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Name of the Society: "ASSOCIATION OF ASSAM VETS IN POULTRY INDUSTRY".
2. Address of the Main office of the Society : House No-115, JIRONI, Saneki Path, Baghorbori, P.O- Panjabari, Dist- Kamrup (M), Guwahati, Assam, Pin-781037.
3. The Area of operation or areas of activity is limited to growth and development of Poultry Industry, welfare of Veterinarians, Farmers & entrepreneurs engaged in Indian Poultry Industry.
4. The Objects of the Society shall be all or any combinations of the followings:
 - a. To establish a communication channel to connect with all the veterinarians from Assam who are engaged in Poultry industry all over the country or abroad.
 - b. To provide facilities for exchange of information and opinion of interest to Poultry farming both Broilers & Layers, Poultry medicines & vaccines manufacturers, Feed mills, Hatcheries and Poultry Breeder Farms and allied sectors.
 - c. To establish communication network with young budding Vets to be a part of Poultry Industry with a purpose of strengthen future competent resources in the sector by conducting online & offline seminars & workshops in the Veterinary colleges and other public and Private Institutions.
 - d. Knowledge sharing sessions about entrepreneurship development in Poultry sector , Leadership development program for its members, expert talks on development of poultry industry, farm management, bio-security and disease diagnosis for poultry farmers & students.
 - e. To represent poultry farming needs to the Union Government, State Government and all bodies that impact the poultry farming activity in Assam and in other states of India.
 - f. To collect and maintain information of poultry farming activity in the State. Sharing the same with its members, Government bodies and policy makers of the State.


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- g. To liaise between poultry farming community, educational institutions and research institutions.
- h. Co-operate with industrial, business, educational and research institutions and other organizations in the collection and exchange of information pertaining to Poultry Farming, Poultry medicines & vaccines manufacturers, Feed mills, Hatcheries and Poultry Breeder Farm etc.
- i. To promote entrepreneurship in the field of Poultry farming, breeding, feed milling and hatcheries or any other ventures related to poultry Industry.
- j. To undertake professional, technical and management consultation services.
- k. To undertake studies, survey and research project. To organize common service facilities for its members.
- l. To conduct, undertake and participate in National and International Exhibition;
- m. To attain those advantages by united action, which each member-unit may not be able to accomplish in its separate capacity.
- n. To construct or alter or keep in repair any buildings required or used by or for the Association and to pulldown or demolish any buildings not to required.
- o. - q. To undertake and execute any trust the undertaking of which may seem to the Association desirable either gratuitously or otherwise.
- r. To bring out and publish for sale or private circulation or free distribution,

- books, newspapers, periodicals, pamphlets or any other publications.
- s. To establish and operate poultry product display centers, sub-contracting exchange sand other institutions for the benefit of Poultry Farming, Hatcheries and Feed mills.
 - t. To organize exhibitions, trade fairs, marketing activities & to undertake generic activities that creates awareness about health benefits of Poultry meat and eggs. Also to help increase poultry & poultry product consumption, achieving aims & objects of the association but not to carry any commercial activities resulting in profits".
 - u. To purchase or acquire technical know-how for development of Poultry Industry.
 - v. To establish test centers, laboratories, common facility centers and undertakes any type of research and development activity, etc. for the Poultry farming and allied sector.
 - w. To work & cooperate with other bodies (industrial, business, educational research, Skill development & training institutions) for conducting joint/ sponsorship skill development programme, that would help in providing skilled manpower to Poultry Industry.
 - x. To generally do all other things incidental to the attainment of the objects.

5. MEMBERSHIP:

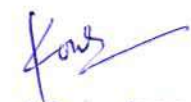
a) QUALIFICATION TO BECOME MEMBER :

Member should be a Veterinarian (Vets) of Assam who are engaged in Poultry Industry of India & abroad.

b) MEMBERSHIP FEE:

- I. A member has to pay an annual membership fee of Rs 1200/- (Rupees Twelve Hundred) which can be paid in two equal installments in six month intervals.
- II. The Annual membership fee can be revised as per the decision of members in the Annual General Body Meeting.


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- III. The General Body Meeting may also decide to incorporate Life membership Fee in due course of time.
- IV. The member is liable to pay subscription for every year for his membership until the member resigns.
- V. The application for membership in the Association shall be submitted in the prescribed form to the General Secretary of the Association.
- VI. Every application for Membership shall be accompanied by the prescribed Annual membership Fee paid by crossed cheque from the Account of the unit; cheques issued in any other name /account shall not be accepted.
- VII. Application for Membership shall be placed before the General Secretary of the Association for the approval. The General Secretary will place it to the executive committee for scrutiny. After scrutiny by the members of the executive committee the membership will be approved and the new member can join in the association by paying the annual membership fee in full for their levant financial year.
- VIII. Acceptance or rejection of the application shall be intimated to the applicant within 15 days from the date of the decision of the Executive Committee and the Executive Committee is bound to assign any reason for rejection of any application. However, the amount, if any, paid shall be refunded to the rejected applicant within the said period of 15 days.
- IX. Any applicant whose application is rejected shall be eligible to make a fresh application after six months from the date of such intimation
- X. There shall be no limit to the maximum number of members the Association may have on its rolls.
- XI. Membership of the Association shall cease:
- a. Upon non-payment of Annual membership fee as a foresaid.
 - b. By Registration: Registration shall be in writing and shall take effect upon settling the dues, if any and from the date of acceptance by Executive Committee.
 - c. Upon closure of unit.
- XII. The Annual membership fee shall fall due on 1st April of each Year.


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- XIII. Members shall pay their Annual membership fee on or before the last day of May of each financial year. There after the Membership ceases.
- XIV. Any Member who fails to pay his annual membership fee before last day of May of the current financial year as a foresaid shall automatically cease to be a member. All service to such members From the Association shall be suspended from the first day of June and he shall not be eligible to contest for any election, or second a candidate or participate in the deliberation or vote at any meeting of the Association.
- XV. Such defaulted members may how ever be re admitted after the General Body Meeting and by payment of the Annual membership fee remaining unpaid for all the years, other dues if any.
- XVI. Any Annual membership fee or subscription or part thereof shall not be refunded on termination, suspension or resignation for membership.
- XVII. Every member of the association shall be entitled to the subsection 1 to 4 provided that the member has paid his subscription and all other dues if any to the Association up to date.
- XVIII. **RIGHTS OF MEMBERSHIP:**
- a. A register of members shall be kept in which shall be set for the names and Addresses of members and in which all changes of membership taking place from time to time shall be recorded.
 - b. Any member who is desirous of contesting for the election as a member to the Executive Committee should have been a member of the Association for at least 6 months prior to the date of filing the nomination papers.
 - c. All members may take part in the proceedings of the General Body Meeting. Only such members who have completed a minimum period of 3months as Members shall exercise their vote.
 - d. Obtain information and advice on all matters in consonance with the objects of the Association and general services offered by the association.
 - e. Send subjects for discussion at conferences/ Meetings.

- f. Make use of the facility of the Association Subject to the rules framed in this behalf from time to time.

c) COLLECTION OF FUNDS:

The funds of the Association shall consist of

1. The Annual membership Fee
2. The Life Membership Fee
3. Voluntary Contribution from Corporates & individuals.
4. Grant from Govt. and other public & private bodies and Institutions.
5. Donations, rent, service charges and others.
6. Process derived from exhibitions, seminars, publication conducted tours and other activities.
7. Income from training programs conducted by AAVPI.
8. Income generated from services rendered.

d) CONTROL OF FUNDS:

- i. All the moneys received by AAVPI shall be remitted on the same day or the next working day to the Bank where AAVPI is maintaining its account, except under extra ordinary circumstances.
- ii. The impress amount to kept with Hon. General Secretary at any time shall not exceed Rs.25,000/-
- iii. The expenses other than normal/ usual shall not exceed Rs.50,000/-per month. If any expenditure exceeds Rs.50,000/-the same on approval by the Executive Committee.
- iv. Investment Clause: The funds of the Association shall be invested in the modes specified under the provisions of S.13 (1){d} read with S.11(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 and amended from time to time.

6. PROCEDURE OF GENERAL BODY MEETING:

There shall be General Body Meeting once in a year of the Society held at a place and on a date to be fixed by the Executive Committee within three months from the close of the financial year of the Association for transacting the following business-


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- a. To pass audited accounts for current year and progress report from the Executive Committee.
- b. To receive and adopt the Annual Report and the statement of Accounts for two years.
- c. To appoint Auditor or Auditors and fixup their remuneration.
- d. To elect nine members of the Executive committee once in Two years.
- e. To transact any other business that may be placed before it by the Executive committee.

The notice period (together with agenda and other documents required under the Bye-law) for the Annual General Body Meeting shall be clear 21 days and for Special General Body Meeting 14 days clear notice to be sent under UCP. Accidental omission to give notice or any member not receiving notice 'sent under UCP there of by him shall not in validate the proceeding of any General Body Meeting or Special General Body Meeting.

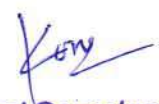
The members intending to place subjects for consideration at the General Body Meeting shall send the same to the Hon. General Secretary at least 7 days before the date of the General Body Meeting and all such subjects shall be placed in the General Body:

If within half an hour from the time appointed for a General or Special General Body Meeting, there is no quorum, the meeting shall stand adjourned by half an hour. At the adjourned meeting the members present for the time being shall constitute the quorum.

SPECIAL GENERAL BODY MEETING:

- I. A special General Body Meeting of the Association may be convened by the President on his own or on requisition of 2/3 Members, of the elected Executive Committee or on requisition by 1/3 of the total Members of the association. Such members who send the requisition shall state in writing the purpose for which they wish the meeting to be convened.
- II. A notice of 14 clear days shall be given for Special General Body Meeting and at such Special General Body Meeting no other business shall be transacted except that


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which is stated in the notice.

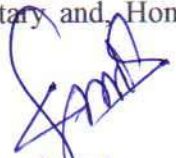
- III. The fore going rules may be amended or repealed by are solution of the Special General Body, passed by a majority of not less than two third of the members present.
- IV. A list of members as on 1st June of the year shall be published 30 days prior to the date of the Annual General Body Meeting. The manner of such publication shall be by displaying the list on the notice board of the Association Office.

7. **QUORUM OF THE GENERAL BODY MEETING:**

The Quorum for the General body meeting and Special General Body meeting shall be a minimum of Fourteen (14) members.

8. **ELECTION PROCEDURE OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE/ GOVERNING BODY:**

- a. Any members who are desirous of contesting for the election as a member to the Executive committee should have been a member of the Association for at least 6 months prior to date of filling the nomination papers.
- b. The President shall nominate an Election Officer with the approval of the Executive Committee. The Election Officer shall be responsible to conduct the election as specified under election rules.
- c. A calendar of events for the election to the Executive Committee shall be published in the Annual Report to be placed before the General Body Meeting.
- d. Members desirous of contesting for election to the Executive Committee should send their nominations duly seconded by a current member in the prescribed Nomination Form as per Calendar of events published.
- e. In tile event of number of valid nominations received: being 09 in accordance with category wise vacancies, the election should be deemed unanimous in case there are no contestants *or* less than required number, in any or all categories, such vacancies can be filled in by co-option from the respective category by the Executive Committee after the election President /Vice President, Hon. General Secretary and, Hon. Treasurer, who shall be elected among and-by the newly


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constituted members of the Executive Committee.

- f. Every member shall have one vote, category as per rule and if this rule is contravened in any manner such a ballot paper shall be in validated.
- g. The vote shall be exercised by a member that is only through the accredited represented as declared earlier by a member and recorded in the Membership Register. However, changes if any in the representative shall be intimated in writing and duly recorded the Membership Register before the first list of members is published. The Quorum for the General meeting and Special General Meeting shall be 14. The quorum for the Executive committee shall be five members. For the adjourned Special General body Meeting Quorum does not apply.
- h. In the Annual General Body Meeting, the required number of scrutinizers shall be nominated well in advance by the Election Officer in Consultation with the President of AAVPI. The Scrutinizers shall not be directly or in directly interested in the process of election.
- i. Members eligible as per the Bye-Law ClauseNo.5(a) and, shall apply to Association-in prescribed form.
- j. Members attending the AGM of AAVPI and elections thereof shall produce the Photo Identity Card without which the member shall not be allowed to participate in the proceedings of the AGM and elections.
- k. The Executive Committee shall form the code of conduct for conducting the election which shall be binding on all the parties concerned.
- l. Canvassing shall riot be allowed within 50 mtrs. Radius of the election premises. The election officer has every right to disqualify such of those candidates who violates the rules.
- m. The Election officer so appointed shall reject the in valid votes during the counting of ballot Papers and shall draw up the election results. Procedures notified by the Election Officer in conducting the election shall be binding on all the candidate.
- n. In the event of at ie. Lots shall be drawn after the announcement of the results by the Election Officer to decide the successful candidate,

- o. The results of the election shall be declared at the General meeting of the Association with details and shall be deemed to be final.
- p. Voting shall be by secret ballot.
 - a. No correction shall be made in the ballot papers even if the candidate retires from the contest. Request for withdrawal from contest shall be considered only if such request is made within the frame work of the election rules applicable at that in the ballot papers even if the candidate retires from the contest. Request for withdrawal from contest shall be considered only if such request is made with in the frame work of the election rules applicable at that time as per the calendar of events.
 - b. All Contested candidates after the expiry of withdrawal date can retire from contest announced by himself in General Body Meeting.
- q. The new Office Bearers shall be elected immediately after the declaration of the election results by the newly elected Members of the Executive Committee.
- r. The Co-option of members to the Executive Committee shall be done by the Executive Committee.
- s. All matters relating to election and election procedures shall be decided by the Election Officer. Objections in respect of scrutiny of nominations, election procedures and announcement of results of election procedures and announcement of results of election shall be filed in writing on the same day respectively to the Election Officer. The Election Officer's decision in all the above matters shall be final.
- t. Disputes in respect of any of the activities/ functioning/ decisions of the Association shall be subject to Guwahati City Jurisdiction.
- u. For all matters which have not been specially provided for here in above, the provision of Societies registration Act 1860 as amended, and rules made there in shall apply.


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9. **SHORT DESCRIPTION OF EXECUTIVE BODY:**

The management of the affairs of the Association shall vest in the Executive Committee Consisting of Nine Members constituted as under.

- i. The AGM will elect Nine Members as Executive Committee Members.
- ii. **President:** The President shall be elected from the nine elected Executive Committee Members at AGM.
- iii. **Executive President:** The Executive President shall be elected from the nine elected Executive Committee Members at AGM.
- iv. **Vice President:** Two nos of Vice President shall be elected from the from the nine Executive Committee Members at AGM.
- v. **General Secretary:** The General Secretary shall be directly elected from the nine elected Executive Committee Members at AGM.
- vi. **Asst. Secretary:** shall be directly from the nine elected Executive Committee Members at AGM.
- vii. **Treasurer:** Shall be directly elected from the nine elected Executive Committee members at AGM.
- viii. **Executive members:** Two nos of executive members shall be directly elected at AGM
- ix. All Nine member selected from among the members of the association.

10. **THE TERMOF THE EXECUTIVE BODY:**

1. The Members of the Executive committee will retire after two years and be eligible for re-election of members to the Executive Committee at an Annual General body Meeting and by a simple majority.
2. Any ordinary member can stand for election for Membership of the Executive Committee even if a sitting Executive Committee member is eligible for re-election. However, notice from the member signifying his intention to stand for election to the executive committee must be received at the Office of the Association, three clear days before the Annual General Meeting. If the office of a member is vacated, the executive Committee may co-opt a member by a simple majority of the Executive Committee to hold office till the next Annual General Meeting.


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3. The term of the President is for a period of One Term, i. e 2 years.
4. The Office bearers and members of the Executive Committee shall hold office till the Office Bearers and members of the incoming Executive Committee assume charge or till the end of the term.
5. The day-to-day management of the Association shall vest with the Officer-bearers consisting of
 - a) One Hon. President.
 - b) One Executive President
 - c) Two nos of Hon. Vice-President
 - d) One Hon. General Secretary
 - e) One Asst Secretary
 - f) One Hon. Treasurer
 - g) Two Executive members
6. The Hon. General Secretary and the Hon. Treasurer shall be elected from among and by the elected members of the Executive Committee, provided such candidates should have served as member for a period of 24 months. Casual vacancies if any in the Office Bearers post shall be filled up by the members of the Executive Committee.

11. PROCEDURE OF RE-ELECTION OF THE MEMBERS OF THE EXECUTIVE BODY:

The procedure of re-election of the members has to go through the election procedures mentioned in the bye laws in the Clause No. 8. The term of the President is only for one term i.e 2 years. All other office bearer can contest elections and can be re-elected for the next term.

12. PROCEDURE OF THE MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

The executive committee meeting will be held twice in a year preferably in 6 months intervals.



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13. QUORUM OF THE MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

The Quorum for the Executive body meeting should be a minimum of five (5) Executive members.

14. EXPULSION OF UNDESIRABLE MEMBERS:

A member may be expelled from Membership of the Association for any act of commission or omission pre judicial to the interest of poultry farming or objectives of the associations in general or violation of the rules and regulation of the Society/ association in particular. Such expulsion shall be done by the Executive Committee; however, such expelled member can appeal to the ensuing General Body of the Association.

15. ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT:

- a. The Executive Committee shall cause true and complete accounts of the transactions of the Association to be kept and the Balance Sheet shall be prepared as on 31st March every year.
- b. The accounts shall be audited by an Audit or duly qualified and duly appointed for the purpose by the General Body who shall audit the accounts of the society at least once in a year and Annual Audit Report will be submitted to the Registrar of Societies regularly.
- c. Amendment Clause: No amendments to the Memorandum of Association and Rules and Regulations shall be made which may prove to be repugnant to the provisions of 8.2 (15), 11, 12 and 13 and 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as amended from time to time. Further no such amendment shall be carried out without the prior approval of the COMMISSIONER OF Income Tax.
- d. The benefits of the Society/Association shall be open to all irrespective of caste, creed or religion.
- e. The funds and the Income of the Association shall be society utilized towards the achievement of the objects and no portion of it shall be utilized for payment to members by way of profit, interest, dividend, etc.



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16. **LEGAL PROCEDURE:**

According to the provision laid down in the section 6 of the Societies Registration Act- XXI of 1860, the society may sue or may be sued in the name of the President and the Secretary of the Society.

17. **DISSOLUTION :**

In the event of dissolution or winding up of the Society/ Association, the assets remaining as on the date of dissolution shall, under no circumstances, be distributed among the Members of the Executive committee/ Members of the Governing Body, but the same shall be transferred to another Charitable Association whose objects are similar to those of this Association and which enjoys recognition under section *BOG* of the Income Tax Act 1961 or to be handed over according to the provision laid down in the Section 13 and 14 of the Society Registration Act- XXI of 1860.
